A HATFIELD woman is in the running for a prestigious Asian Women of Achievement Award.

Jillian Haslam has been nominated in the Social and Humanitarian category, for devoting her energy in helping others.

Born to British parents in Calcutta, Jillian spent 20 years forging a career in banking.

In 2000 she moved to the UK and began her own life improvement and training company, Help Yourself Associates.

The awards aim to champion the contribution made by Asian women across British business, sports, public, cultural, community and political life.

Over their 13-year history, they have recognised, and provided a platform for Asian female pioneers – such as comedy actress Nina Wadia; civil rights activist Shami Chakrabarti; and the first Asian woman to lead a FTSE 250 business, Ruby McGregor-Smith.

The awards will be announced at a glittering ceremony at the London Hilton on Park Lane, on Wednesday, May 16.
